***Please note – if camping on site (Herron Park), Flathead County will collect from me a "camp fee" per campsite per night.. I will announce this amount as it is made known to me, and will then collect the fees from our riders... I anticipate a fee of \$10 per night.

*** Canadian checks require an additional \$10 fee for bank transfer of funds. (Sorry)

*** Stabling fee includes a \$5 per day "grounds fee" or park usage. Flathead County requires a per day stabling fee. Thus 5 days of stabling is required per camper/horse.
